1. Accreditation and access

- » Participation in the Riga StratCom Dialogue 2022 conference in person and access to the media center is only available to accredited media. For accreditation, please visit the Riga StratCom Dialogue 2022 website section Media.
- » Accredited media are welcome to arrive at the conference from 8:30 on 25 May and upon entering the venue will receive their media entrance pass (badge). To receive your badge, please have a form of identification (ID card or Passport) ready.
- » The badge for accredited media will allow media representatives to access the event venue and conference from 25 to 26 May, use the media room for work purposes, and get assistance in arranging interviews with conference speakers.
- » Passes must be visible at all times (including social events) and security personnel may ask to see another form of ID upon arrival at the venue. Security personnel will examine and may test equipment and personal effects carried onto the site. Please leave enough time for these security checks.





5. Facilities and equipment

- » The media center is located in the conference venue at the Hanzas Perons (Hanzas iela 16A, Vidzemes priekšpilsēta, Rīga, LV-1045) on the left side of the main stage.
- » Space in the general working area and/or lounge does not need to be pre-booked.
- » Wi-Fi and wired internet, video and audio distribution points, and standard European electrical outlets will be available at the media center. Information about accessing Wi-Fi will be available at the media center.
- » There will also be screens broadcasting the ongoing conference to the media center. For your convenience, audio from the ongoing conference will be transmitted through the wireless earphones available at the center.

7. Other important information

- » Dress code for civilians is set to business formal, for military personnel service dress uniform (jacket and tie).
- » It is prohibited to carry in explosive and incendiary materials; stunning devices, flammable items (except lighters); pepper spray, tear gas and other gasses and pressure containers; knives and objects with a sharp point or sharp edge; firearms (including firearm replicas and firearm parts) and ammunition to the venue. Be prepared to present your personal belongings for inspection if requested by security personnel.
